



Brief Description

Beni Suez University is a public University. It is focused on becoming a research-led University. It has already commenced the implementation a strategy to strengthen its research enterprise and to facilitate cross-disciplinary interaction - within and beyond the University. The University is about to finish the initial stage of the development of 'Research City' at its new huge campus near the banks of the Nile River.

A distinctive feature of the University is its remarkably broad range, with 22 faculties and 50,447 students. The University undertakes research and teaching in the basic and medical sciences, humanities and social sciences, in applied health and professional disciplines, and in engineering and computer sciences. This breadth means that the University can build strong links between theory and practice, and between the university and the broader community of which it is a part.

It sees further internationalisation as a strategic priority and is seeking an active partnership with Foreign Universities and Institutions in the form of programs, centres of excellence, joint degrees, agreements and exchange expertise.

Brief History

Beni Suez University is a dynamic and relatively new comprehensive University located in Beni Suez City - about 120 km south of Cairo—with easy access to various forms of transportation. From 1981-2005 it was a branch campus of Cairo University (1981-2005). In 2005, the University was granted its independent status and since then it has witnessed major changes in its infrastructure.

The university is situated in the city of Beni Suez which is located in the heart of Upper Egypt, close to the land of ancient civilizations and pharaonic monuments. The city is famous for the production of medicinal and aromatic plants, hand-made carpets and the cement industry. Samsung, the global leader in electronics, has located its massive electronics factory here.
